In this interesting Southdown model we found fleet number 423, registration number GUF 123 operating on route 13B to North Moulscombe. When creating the artwork for this model the East Sussex destination gave us some cause for concern until we discovered that the town name had been changed in the 1950's to Moulescoomb.
